FOLLOW CHRIST INTO “HIS REST” OVERCOMING “THE WILDERNESS”!
WHY DID THE CHILDREN OF ISREAL FAIL?
THEY HARDENED THEIR HEARTS W/UNBELIEF! (HEB 3:6-19)

(Matt 4:1-11 KJV)

- 1) Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil.
- 2) And when he had fasted forty days and forty nights, he was afterward an hungered.

(Matt 4:3 KJV)

- 3) And when the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread.

(Matt 4:4 KJV) **TEMPTATION COMES TO TEST “IF YOU ARE A SON OF GOD”**

- 4) But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God. (Deut 8:3)

(Matt 4:6 KJV)

- 6) And saith unto him, If thou be the Son of God, cast thyself down: for it is written, He shall give his angels charge concerning thee: and in *their* hands they shall bear thee up, lest at any time thou dash thy foot against a stone. (Ps 91:9-12)

(Matt 4:7 KJV)

- 7) Jesus said unto him, It is written again, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God. (Deut 6:16 & Ex 17:7)

(Matt 4:8-9 KJV)

- 8) Again, the devil taketh him up into an exceeding high mountain, and showeth him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them;

- 9) And saith unto him, All these things will I give thee, if thou wilt fall down and worship me.

(Matt 4:10 KJV)

- 10) Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve. (Ex 34:14)

(Matt 4:11 KJV)

- 11) Then the devil leaveth him, and, behold, angels came and ministered unto him. (Heb 1:14)

(Luke 4:13 KJV)

- 13) And when the devil had ended all the temptation, he departed from him for a season. (1 Thess 5:1-5)

(TEST #1) LIVE BY EVERY WORD OF GOD “RHEMA = SPOKEN” & “LOGOS = WRITTEN”!

(TEST #2) DO NOT TEMPT GOD WITH FOOLISH BEHAVIOR, ANGELS ARE WATCHING OVER THE HEIRS OF SALVATION (HEB 1:14), GOD’S HOLY SPIRIT WILL NEVER FORSAKE US (HEB 13:5), AND GOD’S PEOPLE SHOULD WALK IN FAITH WITHOUT COMPLAINING “IS GOD WITH US?” (EX 17:7)!

(TEST #3) WORSHIP & SERVE GOD ONLY AND GOD WILL PROVIDE ALL THAT IS NEEDED (MATT 6:33 & ROM 14:17)! NEVER BOW TO ANY OTHER GODS FOR POWER OR MONEY!

(SPIRITUAL RESULT #1) EVIL LEAVES & ANGELS MINISTER! (MATT 4:11 & HEB 1:14)

(SPIRITUAL RESULT #2) WARNING! EVIL WILL RETURN LATER IN ANOTHER SEASON! (LUKE 4:13 & 1 THESS 5:1-5) (Eph 6:11 KJV) Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

(SPIRITUAL RESULT #3) CHRIST EMPOWERMENT TO RETURN IN POWER OF THE HOLY SPIRIT! (Luke 4:14 KJV) And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about.



(Psalms 91)

- 1) He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.
- 2) I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust.
- 3) Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, *and* from the noisome pestilence.
- 4) He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth *shall be thy* shield and buckler.
- 5) Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; *nor* for the arrow *that* flieth by day;
- 6) *Nor* for the pestilence *that* walketh in darkness; *nor* for the destruction *that* wasteth at noonday.
- 7) A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come nigh thee.
- 8) Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked.
- 9) Because thou hast made the LORD, *which is* my refuge, *even* the most High, thy habitation;
- 10) There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling.
- 11) For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways.
- 12) They shall bear thee up in *their* hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone.
- 13) Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shalt thou trample under feet.
- 14) Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name.
- 15) He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I *will be* with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him.
- 16) With long life will I satisfy him, and show him my salvation.
