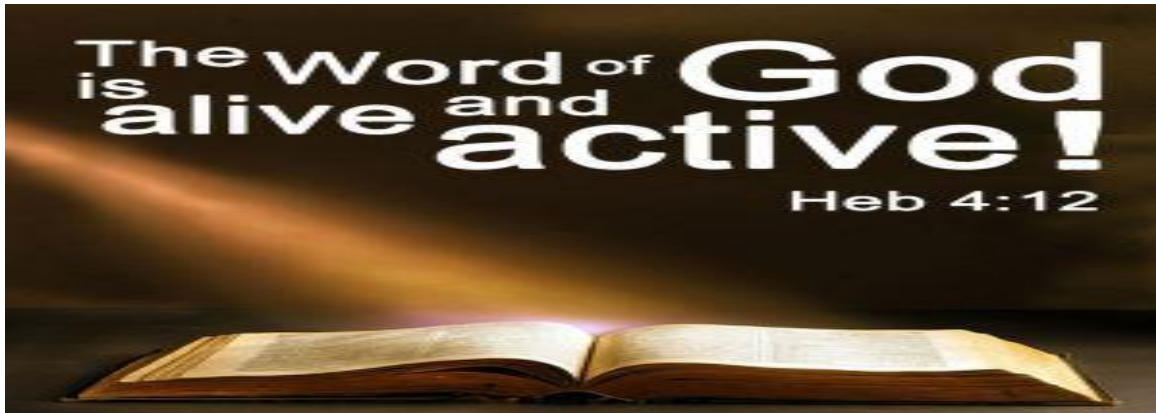

Perhaps from the same as **G3735** (through the idea of *elevation*); the *sky*; by extension *heaven* (as the abode of God); by implication *happiness, power, eternity*; specifically the *Gospel (Christianity)*:—air, heaven ([-ly]), sky.

Probably a from an obsolete word -ñù oroô (to *rise* or "rear"; perhaps akin to **G142**; compare **G3733**); a mountain (as *lifting itself above the plain*):—hill, mount (-ain).

(Mat 6:33 KJV) "But seek ye first the **kingdom of God**, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you."

(Mat 12:28 KJV) "But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the **kingdom of God** is come unto you."

(Mat 19:24 KJV) "And again I say unto you, It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the **kingdom of God.**"

(Mat 21:31 KJV) "Whether of them twain did the will of *his* father? They say unto him, The first. Jesus saith unto them, Verily I say unto you, That the publicans and the harlots go into the **kingdom of God** before you."

(Mat 21:43 KJV) "Therefore say I unto you, The **kingdom of God** shall be taken from you, and given to a nation bringing forth the fruits thereof."

(Mark 1:14 KJV) "Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the **kingdom of God,**"

(Mark 1:15 KJV) "And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the **kingdom of God** is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel."

(Mark 4:11 KJV) "And he said unto them, Unto you it is given to know the mystery of the **kingdom of God:** but unto them that are without, all *these* things are done in parables:"

(Mark 4:26 KJV) "And he said, So is the **kingdom of God**, as if a man should cast seed into the ground;"

(Mark 4:30 KJV) "And he said, Whereunto shall we liken the **kingdom of God?** or with what comparison shall we compare it?"

(Mark 9:1 KJV) "And he said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That there be some of them that stand here, which shall not taste of death, till they have seen the **kingdom of God** come with power."

(Mark 9:47 KJV) "And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out: it is better for thee to enter into the **kingdom of God** with one eye, than having two eyes to be cast into hell fire:"

(Mark 10:14 KJV) "But when Jesus saw *it*, he was much displeased, and said unto them, Suffer the little children to come unto me, and forbid them not: for of such is the **kingdom of God.**"

(Mark 10:15 KJV) "Verily I say unto you, Whosoever shall not receive the **kingdom of God** as a little child, he shall not enter therein."

(Mark 10:23 KJV) "And Jesus looked round about, and saith unto his disciples, **How hardly shall they that have riches enter into the kingdom of God!**"

(Mark 10:24 KJV) "And the disciples were astonished at his words. But Jesus answereth again, and saith unto them, **Children, how hard is it for them that trust in riches to enter into the kingdom of God!**"

(Mark 10:25 KJV) "**It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God.**"

(Mark 12:34 KJV) "And when Jesus saw that he answered discreetly, he said unto him, **Thou art not far from the kingdom of God.** And no man after that durst ask him *any question.*"

(Mark 14:25 KJV) "**Verily I say unto you, I will drink no more of the fruit of the vine, until that day that I drink it new in the kingdom of God.**"

(Mark 15:43 KJV) "Joseph of Arimathaea, an honourable counsellor, which also waited for the **kingdom of God**, came, and went in boldly unto Pilate, and craved the body of Jesus."

(Luke 4:43 KJV) "And he said unto them, **I must preach the kingdom of God to other cities also: for therefore am I sent.**"

(Luke 6:20 KJV) "And he lifted up his eyes on his disciples, and said, **Blessed be ye poor: for yours is the kingdom of God.**"

(Luke 7:28 KJV) "**For I say unto you, Among those that are born of women there is not a greater prophet than John the Baptist: but he that is least in the kingdom of God is greater than he.**"

(Luke 8:1 KJV) "And it came to pass afterward, that he went throughout every city and village, preaching and showing the glad tidings of the **kingdom of God**: and the twelve *were* with him,"

(Luke 8:10 KJV) "And he said, **Unto you it is given to know the mysteries of the kingdom of God: but to others in parables; that seeing they might not see, and hearing they might not understand.**"

(Luke 9:2 KJV) "And he sent them to preach the **kingdom of God**, and to heal the sick."

(Luke 9:11 KJV) "And the people, when they knew *it*, followed him: and he received them, and spake unto them of the **kingdom of God**, and healed them that had need of healing."

(Luke 9:27 KJV) "**But I tell you of a truth, there be some standing here, which shall not taste of death, till they see the kingdom of God.**"

(Luke 9:60 KJV) "Jesus said unto him, **Let the dead bury their dead: but go thou and preach the kingdom of God.**"

(Luke 9:62 KJV) "And Jesus said unto him, **No man, having put his hand to the plow, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God.**"

(Luke 10:9 KJV) "And heal the sick that are therein, and say unto them, The **kingdom of God** is come nigh unto you."

(Luke 10:11 KJV) "Even the very dust of your city, which cleaveth on us, we do wipe off against you: notwithstanding be ye sure of this, that the **kingdom of God** is come nigh unto you."

(Luke 11:20 KJV) "But if I with the finger of God cast out devils, no doubt the **kingdom of God** is come upon you."

(Luke 12:31 KJV) "But rather seek ye the **kingdom of God**; and all these things shall be added unto you."

(Luke 13:18 KJV) "Then said he, **Unto what is the kingdom of God like? and whereunto shall I resemble it?**"

(Luke 13:20 KJV) "And again he said, **Whereunto shall I liken the kingdom of God?**"

(Luke 13:28 KJV) "There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when ye shall see Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, and all the prophets, in the **kingdom of God**, and you *yourselves* thrust out."

(Luke 13:29 KJV) "And they shall come from the east, and *from* the west, and from the north, and *from* the south, and shall sit down in the **kingdom of God.**"

(Luke 17:20 KJV) "And when he was demanded of the Pharisees, when the **kingdom of God** should come, he answered them and said, **The kingdom of God** cometh not with observation:"

(Luke 17:21 KJV) "Neither shall they say, Lo here! or, lo there! for, behold, the **kingdom of God** is within you."

(Luke 18:16 KJV) "But Jesus called them *unto him*, and said, **Suffer little children to come unto me, and forbid them not: for of such is the kingdom of God.**"

(Luke 18:17 KJV) "Verily I say unto you, Whosoever shall not receive the **kingdom of God** as a little child shall in no wise enter therein."

(Luke 18:24 KJV) "And when Jesus saw that he was very sorrowful, he said, **How hardly shall they that have riches enter into the kingdom of God!**"

(Luke 18:25 KJV) "For it is easier for a camel to go through a needle's eye, than for a rich man to enter into the **kingdom of God.**"

(Luke 19:11 KJV) "And as they heard these things, he added and spake a parable, because he was nigh to Jerusalem, and because they thought that the **kingdom of God** should immediately appear."

(Luke 21:31 KJV) "So likewise ye, when ye see these things come to pass, know ye that the **kingdom of God** is nigh at hand."

(Luke 22:16 KJV) "For I say unto you, I will not any more eat thereof, until it be fulfilled in the **kingdom of God.**"

(Luke 22:18 KJV) "For I say unto you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine, until the **kingdom of God** shall come."

(Luke 23:51 KJV) "(The same had not consented to the counsel and deed of them;) *he was* of Arimathaea, a city of the Jews: who also himself waited for the **kingdom of God.**"

(John 3:3 KJV) "Jesus answered and said unto him, **Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.**"

(John 3:5 KJV) "Jesus answered, **Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.**"

(Acts 1:3 KJV) "To whom also he showed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the **kingdom of God:**"

(Acts 8:12 KJV) "But when they believed Philip preaching the things concerning the **kingdom of God**, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women."

(Acts 14:22 KJV) "Confirming the souls of the disciples, *and* exhorting them to continue in the faith, and that we must through much tribulation enter into the **kingdom of God.**"

(Acts 19:8 KJV) "And he went into the synagogue, and spake boldly for the space of three months, disputing and persuading the things concerning the **kingdom of God.**"

(Acts 20:25 KJV) "And now, behold, I know that ye all, among whom I have gone preaching the **kingdom of God**, shall see my face no more."

(Acts 28:23 KJV) "And when they had appointed him a day, there came many to him into *his* lodging; to whom he expounded and testified the **kingdom of God**, persuading them

concerning Jesus, both out of the law of Moses, and *out of* the prophets, from morning till evening."

(Acts 28:31 KJV) "Preaching the **kingdom of God**, and teaching those things which concern the Lord Jesus Christ, with all confidence, no man forbidding him."

(Rom 14:17 KJV) "For the **kingdom of God** is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost."

(1 Cor 4:20 KJV) "For the **kingdom of God** *is* not in word, but in power."

(1 Cor 6:9 KJV) "Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the **kingdom of God**? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind,"

(1 Cor 6:10 KJV) "Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the **kingdom of God**."

(1 Cor 15:50 KJV) "Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the **kingdom of God**; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption."

(Gal 5:21 KJV) "Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told *you* in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the **kingdom of God**."

(Col 4:11 KJV) "And Jesus, which is called Justus, who are of the circumcision. These only *are* my fellowworkers unto the **kingdom of God**, which have been a comfort unto me."

(2 Th 1:5 KJV) "*Which is* a manifest token of the righteous judgment of God, that ye may be counted worthy of the **kingdom of God**, for which ye also suffer:"

(Mat 3:2 KJV) "And saying, Repent ye: for the **kingdom of heaven** is at hand."

(Mat 4:17 KJV) "From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, **Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.**"

(Mat 5:3 KJV) "**Blessed *are* the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.**"

(Mat 5:10 KJV) "**Blessed *are* they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.**"

(Mat 5:19 KJV) "Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the **kingdom of heaven**: but whosoever shall do and teach *them*, the same shall be called great in the **kingdom of heaven**."

(Mat 5:20 KJV) "For I say unto you, That except your righteousness shall exceed *the righteousness* of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the **kingdom of heaven**."

(Mat 7:21 KJV) "Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the **kingdom of heaven**; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven."

(Mat 8:11 KJV) "And I say unto you, That many shall come from the east and west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the **kingdom of heaven**."

(Mat 10:7 KJV) "And as ye go, preach, saying, The **kingdom of heaven** is at hand."

(Mat 11:12 KJV) "And from the days of John the Baptist until now the **kingdom of heaven** suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force."

(Mat 13:11 KJV) "He answered and said unto them, Because it is given unto you to know the mysteries of the **kingdom of heaven**, but to them it is not given."

(Mat 13:24 KJV) "Another parable put he forth unto them, saying, The **kingdom of heaven** is likened unto a man which sowed good seed in his field:"

(Mat 13:31 KJV) "Another parable put he forth unto them, saying, The **kingdom of heaven** is like to a grain of mustard seed, which a man took, and sowed in his field:"

(Mat 13:33 KJV) "Another parable spake he unto them; The **kingdom of heaven** is like unto leaven, which a woman took, and hid in three measures of meal, till the whole was leavened."

(Mat 13:44 KJV) "Again, the **kingdom of heaven** is like unto treasure hid in a field; the which when a man hath found, he hideth, and for joy thereof goeth and selleth all that he hath, and buyeth that field."

(Mat 13:45 KJV) "Again, the **kingdom of heaven** is like unto a merchant man, seeking goodly pearls:"

(Mat 13:47 KJV) "Again, the **kingdom of heaven** is like unto a net, that was cast into the sea, and gathered of every kind:"

(Mat 13:52 KJV) "Then said he unto them, Therefore every scribe *which is* instructed unto the **kingdom of heaven** is like unto a man *that is* an householder, which bringeth forth out of his treasure *things* new and old."

(Mat 16:19 KJV) "And I will give unto thee the keys of the **kingdom of heaven:** and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven."

(Mat 18:1 KJV) "At the same time came the disciples unto Jesus, saying, Who is the greatest in the **kingdom of heaven?**"

(Mat 18:3 KJV) "And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the **kingdom of heaven.**"

(Mat 18:4 KJV) "Whosoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child, the same is greatest in the **kingdom of heaven.**"

(Mat 18:23 KJV) "Therefore is the **kingdom of heaven** likened unto a certain king, which would take account of his servants."

(Mat 19:14 KJV) "But Jesus said, Suffer little children, and forbid them not, to come unto me: for of such is the **kingdom of heaven.**"

(Mat 19:23 KJV) "Then said Jesus unto his disciples, Verily I say unto you, That a rich man shall hardly enter into the **kingdom of heaven.**"

(Mat 20:1 KJV) "For the **kingdom of heaven** is like unto a man *that is* an householder, which went out early in the morning to hire labourers into his vineyard."

(Mat 22:2 KJV) "The **kingdom of heaven** is like unto a certain king, which made a marriage for his son,"

(Mat 23:13 KJV) "But woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye shut up the **kingdom of heaven** against men: for ye neither go in *yourselves*, neither suffer ye them that are entering to go in."

(Mat 25:1 KJV) "Then shall the **kingdom of heaven** be likened unto ten virgins, which took their lamps, and went forth to meet the bridegroom."

(Mat 25:14 KJV) "For *the kingdom of heaven* is as a man travelling into a far country, *who* called his own servants, and delivered unto them his goods."



PSALMS 91 PROTECTION



(Psalms 91)

- 1) He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.
- 2) I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust.
- 3) Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, *and* from the noisome pestilence.
- 4) He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth *shall be thy* shield and buckler.
- 5) Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; *nor* for the arrow *that* flieth by day;
- 6) *Nor* for the pestilence *that* walketh in darkness; *nor* for the destruction *that* wasteth at noonday.
- 7) A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come nigh thee.
- 8) Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked.
- 9) Because thou hast made the LORD, *which is* my refuge, *even* the most High, thy habitation;
- 10) There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling.
- 11) For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways.
- 12) They shall bear thee up in *their* hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone.
- 13) Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shalt thou trample under feet.
- 14) Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name.
- 15) He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him.
- 16) With long life will I satisfy him, and show him my salvation.
